



## INFORMATION SHEET

Thank you for your interest in Youth On Wheels.

Youth On Wheels provides an opportunity for young people (16-25 y.o.) with a Learner's permit, who otherwise lack the support to do so, to achieve the required supervised driving hours in order to be eligible to attain a provisional driving licence.

### Eligibility for the Youth On Wheels program:

- 16 – 25 years old
- Hold a valid learners permit
- Have no other means of access to a supervising driver
- Have completed a sufficient number of professional driving lessons (minimum 3 lessons) to be declared competent at safely operating a motor vehicle under supervision.

*\*Participants MUST have the instructor/driving school complete a Driving Competency Report to be returned along with a completed Referral Form.*

### Program Cost:

The program costs \$ 5 per supervised driving session. This cost is simply in place to cover the costs of fuel, registration and insurance.

*\*PLEASE NOTE: Professional driving lessons prior to entry and during the Youth On Wheels program are at the participants own cost.*

### Referral Process:

Referrals are welcome at any time; however time of entry into the program is dependent on volunteer availability.

Once a young person is accepted into the program, they will be required to attend a free pre-entry workshop which covers road safety, communication, dealing with peer influence, cooperation and decision making.
