### What to put in your recycling bin

- Paper and cardboard (flatten boxes)
- Pizza boxes (remove lids)
- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Milk & juice cartons (rinsed)
- Glass jars & bottles (no lids & rinsed)
- Aluminium cans, steel cans (empty, rinsed, dry)
- Plastic bottles & containers (rinsed)

### What NOT to put in your recycling bin

- Greenwaste/organic/food scraps
- Styrofoam
- Electrical goods
- Computer, mobile phones, e-waste
- Nappies
- Steel products other than steel cans
- Food soiled pizza boxes

**Do not bag your recycling**

**As our service is fortnightly rotation, it is imperative that bins are placed out the night before or prior to 6am on the day of your service to ensure collection, as the contractor may change the collection time without notice.** 70kg is the lifting capacity of this service and overweight bins may lead to non-collection at the contractor's discretion.

Please ensure your bin is placed with the bin lid opening towards the truck and the lid is kept closed to prevent animal scavenging and wind blowing rubbish along the roadside.

## HOUSEHOLD WASTE BIN (RED LID)

This is to be used for household waste only excluding any recyclable materials listed above. Materials that can be placed into your refuse MGB include kitchen scraps, nappies, and contaminated plastics/cardboard/paper.

Alternatively food scraps can be recycled by the use of a worm farm or compost bin.

## GREEN WASTE

Green Waste including lawn clippings, pruning's, weeds, small twigs etc.

**MUST NOT BE PLACED IN EITHER BIN.**

## REPLACEMENT BINS

Replacement bins can be issued at the OWNERS expense.
