RURAL LIVING AND TOWNSHIP ZONES BOUNDARIES REVIEW AND MASTER PLAN FOR DISTRICT COUNCIL OF GRANT

The District Council of Grant is about to conduct extensive investigations and consultation to prepare a Rural Living and Township Zones – Boundaries Review and Master Plan for all the Council area.

The Review and Master Plan will be a significant reference and planning document for Council and the community, and will provide a vision for the zoning of rural living and township land, and sustainable development activity into the future.

District Council of Grant CEO, David Singe said, “The Review and Master Plan will enable Council to proceed with any required zoning and planning policy work; prioritise projects; source funding; and work with land owners, developers and the community to ensure that appropriate land is available in the Council area for future rural living and township growth and development.”

Council has appointed a consultant team from MasterPlan SA Pty Ltd (town and country planners) to undertake the project.

The consultant team will be in the local area between 17 October 2018 and 19 October 2018 to consult with the community, key stakeholders and Council.
