

WASTE TRANSFER STATION CASHLESS VOUCHER SYSTEM

EFFECTIVE FROM 1 JULY 2020

Each property in the District Council of Grant is eligible for a cashless Waste Transfer Station voucher at the commencement of each financial year.

The voucher card entitles the resident / tenant to 6 visits, replacing the vouchers previously provided on the rates notices and bonus vouchers issued separately.

A heaped tandem trailer load of **segregated** waste is considered to be the maximum quantity for each visit on the voucher card.

Segregated loads of scrap metal are free, and green waste during the fire danger season will not constitute a visit on the voucher.

Additional vouchers can be purchased at the Council Office in Mount Gambier and at the Port MacDonnell Community Complex during business hours.

HOW TO OBTAIN YOUR CASHLESS VOUCHER

Upon request Council will arrange vouchers to be processed and mailed out to you, or by prior arrangement the vouchers can be collected from a designated Waste Transfer Station when open.



Once COVID-19 restrictions are lifted, vouchers will be available for collection at the Council Office at 324 Commercial Street West, Mount Gambier and at the Port MacDonnell Community Complex during business hours.
