

COUNCIL UPDATE

Port MacDonnell requires a major dredging campaign to remove significant accumulation of sandy materials at the harbour entrance and mooring grounds as well as seaweed (wrack) removal from the channel. Wrack dredged from the channel will be screened, drained, and transported to the adjacent western beach or offsite. Sand dredged from the harbor entrance will be deposited for replenishment of sandy beaches located east of the harbor area.

Dredging will ensure the safe and continuing access for those using the Port MacDonnell Harbour, boat ramp and mooring grounds.

Works will be undertaken between late March 2022 and July 2022 (weather permitting) as this is a quieter period on the water. During this time the Harbour entrance will still be accessible but boats using the boat haven entrance are advised to use caution and follow the 4-knot speed limit that applies and maintain a safe speed within 100m of the dredge and discharge pipelines. The boat ramp will be limited to one lane through to approximately the end of April 2022.
