- 1. That in exercise of the powers contained in section 246 of the Local Government Act 1999, having satisfied the consultation requirements of the Act and having had regard to the submission received from the public, the National Competition Policy Report, the Certificates of Validity provided by the Council's legal practitioner, the letter or approval from the Minister or Infrastructure and Transport in respect of By-laws numbers 2 and 5, and the comments from the Dog and Cat Management Board in relation to By-Law number 5, the majority of Council, in the presence of at least two thirds of its members, hereby makes and passes the following By-laws as attached and marked 'Attachment 1':
 - a. Permits and Penalties By-law No. 1 of 2021;
 - b. Local Government Land By-law No. 2 of 2021;
 - c. Roads By-law No. 3 of 2021;
 - d. Moveable Signs By-law No. 4 of 2021; and
 - e. Dogs By-law No. 5 of 2021.
- 2. That the Chief Executive officer be authorised to undertake all steps necessary to finalise the By-law review process and to give effect to the newly adopted By-laws.

2. Review of By-Laws - [15.13.1/1] Item 13.1.2
Council were asked to consider By-law application resolutions which will be required in respect of certain designated areas.

Moved Cr Bain that Council

- Pursuant to the power contained in section 246(3)(e) of the Local Government Act 1999, the Council resolves that, once operational, clause 9.9.1 of By-law No. 2 – Local Government Land 2021 will apply to prohibit a person from launching or retrieving a boat to or from the waters at the following locations:
 - a. Adjacent to the township of Blackfellows Caves, other than via the boat ramp access that is permanently located in that area.

- 2. Pursuant to the power contained in section 246(3)(e) of the Local Government Act 1999, the Council resolves that, once operational, clause 9.10.1 of By-law No. 2 Local Government Land 2021 will apply to the boat ramps located at:
 - a. Section 804, Hundred MacDonnell (Tenterden Reserve, Sea Parade, Port MacDonnell), and
 - b. Section 621, Hd Kongorong (Blackfellows Caves).
- 4. Pursuant to the power contained in section 246(3)(e) of the Local Government Act 1999, the Council resolves that, once operational, clause 9.26.4 of By-law No. 2 Local Government Land 2021 will apply to prohibit a person from playing a game of golf on any Council land which is not a designated golf course located at:
 - a. The Blue Lake Golf Club. or
 - b. The Port MacDonnell Golf Club.
- 5. Pursuant to the power contained in section 246(3)(e) of the Local Government Act 1999, the Council resolves that, once operational, clause 9.35.1 of By-law No. 2 Local Government Land 2021 will apply to cause a person to be permitted to engage in the following activities at the Little Blue Lake located at Mount Salt Road. Mount Schank:
 - a. Swimming access via the available pontoon and complying with Council's condition, specifically that jumping or diving from cliffs and/or edges of the lake is not permitted, and
 - b. Scuba Diving restricted to divers who have obtained the requisite Council Permit to Dive and who are a current member of the Cave Diving Association of Australia (CDAA) being the relevant authority, and who hold the necessary qualification as a Deep Cavern Diver.
- 6. Pursuant to the power contained in section 246(3)(e) of the Local Government Act 1999, the Council resolves that, once operational, clause 9.1.1 of By-law No. 5 Dogs 2021 will apply to cause a person to ensure their dog remains on-leash at the following locations:
 - a. Port MacDonnell foreshore reserve areas extending from Smiths Road to the beach access road to the eastern side of the Port MacDonnell Foreshore Tourist Park (except within playground areas prohibited under clause 10.1.1 of the by-law),
 - Port MacDonnell Foreshore Tourist Park located at 12 Eight Mile Creek Road, Port MacDonnell,
 - All Council owned sportsgrounds as identified in the Council's Community Land Register (except within playground areas prohibited under clause 10.1.1 of the by-law),
 - d. Lions Park, located at the corner of Compton Street and Sea Parade, Port MacDonnell (except within playground area prohibited under clause 10.1.1 of the by-law),
 - e. Donovans Landing Reserve, located at Donovans Landing Access Road, Donovans (except within playground areas prohibited under clause 10.1.1 of the by-law),
 - f. Unger Recreation Reserve, located at Hammer Parade, Blackfellows Caves (except within playground areas prohibited under clause 10.1.1 of the by-law),

- g. Volunteer Park, located at the corner of Charles and Meylin Streets, Port MacDonnell,
- h. Blackfellows Caves Boat Ramp and carpark area, located at Height Drive, Blackfellows Caves,
- i. Pony Club at the Mount Gambier Airport, located at 81 Airport Road, Wandilo,
- j. Mount Schank State Heritage Area, located at Mountain Path Road, Mount Schank, and
- k. Little Blue Lake, located at Mount Salt Road, Mount Schank.
- 7. Pursuant to the power contained in section 246(3)(e) of the Local Government Act 1999, the Council resolves that, once operational, clause 10.1.2 of By-law No. 5 Dogs 2021 will apply to prohibit a person from taking a dog into, or allowing a dog to remain, at the following locations:
 - a. Cemetery Reserve at Cape Northumberland, Port MacDonnell.
