



## DISTRICT COUNCIL OF GRANT CASHLESS VOUCHER SYSTEM FOR THE WASTE TRANSFER STATIONS

The Council waste transfer stations no longer accept cash payments for use of the sites. Each DCG property assessment is entitled to a six visit voucher pass (example below) per financial year. These vouchers are individually numbered and remain linked to the property.

Additional vouchers can be purchased from the Commercial Street West Council Office. These can be issued as singular or the six visit passes.

Single Visit - \$50.00  
Six Visit Pass - \$200.00



### How will the cashless system work?

- Step 1 –** Resident presents voucher to the attendant
- Step 2 –** The load of waste will be assessed and the resident's voucher hole punched, if applicable. (Disposal of some materials will be free)
- Step 3 –** Attendant directs resident to the appropriate location. The resident complies with the safety requirements of the site and unloads the waste materials.

The voucher will remain active even when all passes have been used (hole-punched), as an identification card for load types that are deemed to be free.

## FREE ITEMS

<b>SCRAP METAL</b>	Residential quantities only - vehicles need to be decommissioned - whitegoods must be degassed  🌀 <b>Note - if the appliance is not degassed, it will not be accepted</b>
<b>E-WASTE</b>	Residential quantities only
<b>WASTE MOTOR OIL</b>	Residential quantities only
<b>GREEN WASTE</b>	During declared fire season only  🌀 <b>Note – out of fire danger season disposal might require a visit pass. It will depend on volume and contamination level.</b>  <i>Example:</i> A resident presenting with a single garbage bag of green waste outside of fire season will not be considered a visit. However, if the person/vehicle does multiple trips within a short period of time, it will be assessed proportionally to a heaped tandem trailer load.
<b>MATTRESSES</b>	– components must be separated – where it is just the one mattress and no other general waste on the load, it will be free of charge.  🌀 <b>Note – if mattress is not separated, it will not be accepted</b>

## VOUCHER VISIT PASS

<b>TANDEM TRAILER LOAD OF GENERAL WASTE (NOT SEGREGATED) = 1 VOUCHER DOT (HOLE-PUNCHED)</b>	
<b>GENERAL WASTE</b>	If load is greater than 50% general waste – <b>1 VOUCHER DOT (HOLE-PUNCHED)</b>
<b>MIXED TRAILER LOAD</b> (already segregated or visitor prepared to separate)	If load is clearly less than 50% general waste – <b>½ VOUCHER DOT (HOLE PUNCHED)</b>
<b>GREEN WASTE</b> Outside of declared fire season	Tandem trailer – All green waste – <b>½ VOUCHER DOT (HOLE PUNCHED)</b>
<b>CARDBOARD</b>	Tandem trailer – All Cardboard – <b>½ VOUCHER DOT (HOLE PUNCHED)</b>
<b>FURNITURE</b> Unable to be separated	<b>1 VOUCHER DOT (HOLE-PUNCHED)</b> 🌀 <b>Note – Large Furniture is only accepted at Port MacDonnell &amp; Tarpeena WST sites (designated skip bins)</b>
<b>SMALL TRUCK LOAD OF GENERAL WASTE</b>	<b>2 VOUCHER DOTS (HOLE-PUNCHED)</b> (dependent on volume)
