Works are underway on two major projects at the Mount Gambier and District Sale Yards. The installation of a new effluent pit and two new electronic loading ramps. Both projects will improve the safety, animal welfare, and amenities



at the Yards. Council has worked in partnership with the Bay Town Group who successfully applied for

Senior Grant funding to install an outdoor ping pong table on the Port MacDonnell Town Green. Community and visitors are encouraged to borrow free bats and balls from the Port Mac Community Complex and get out and have a hit on the new active recreation asset.

Consultation has been undertaken on a number of key Council projects including the Rating Review and the draft Annual Business Plan and Budget 2021-22.

Council's milestones that have been achieved to date: Completion of the Mount Gambier Regional Airport upgrade worth over \$9 million thanks to a partnership with 3 tiers of Government. It's a place we can all be proud of! The all abilities nature based playground on the waterfront at Port MacDonnell is completed and open for use. Built by local contractors with community input into the concept.

As part of our vision Council has started major works at the Mount Gambier and District Saleyards with cattle ramp upgrades and new effluent dump point for livestock carriers.

Council has joined neighbouring Councils to study coastal adaptation and planning/building codes for coastal zones and have been successful with a grant application from the State Government in conjunction with Flinders University.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Incorporated not-for-profit organisations based in or servicing the DCG that:

- Do not collect substantial income from other sources and
- Provide a valuable service or benefit to the DCG community

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO APPLY?

- A project or event that responds to a community need or helps build a stronger community in the DCG
- Public Liability Insurance or the capacity to take out appropriate coverage
- Quotes to support your application

COMMUNITY HALLS

- Maximum Council allocation \$1000
- Council 75% (up to \$1K) and applicant 25% contribution

COMMUNITY GROUPS

- Maximum Council allocation \$2,500
- Council 75% (up to \$2.5K) and applicant 25% contribution

SPORTING CLUBS

- Maximum Council allocation \$800
- Council 50% (up to \$800) and applicant 50% contribution

PROJECT IDEAS

- Kitchen upgrades
- Water tanks
- Fire alarm install
- Painting or flooring
- Paths or ramps

PROJECT IDEAS

- Printing or promotional materials
